Danko Jevtović is a digital governance leader and fiduciary steward with extensive experience in internet infrastructure, board governance, and nonprofit operations. He recently served as Vice-Chair of the ICANN Board (2022–2024) and Chair of the Board Finance Committee (2020–2024), where he oversaw a \$150M annual operating budget and \$500M in funds under management. During his tenure, he directed the organization's investment strategy, including the Reserve Fund, and championed a strategic cost-savings plan that delivered significant structural cost reductions. His leadership at ICANN provided him with deep, practical expertise in U.S. 501(c)(3) fiduciary governance, financial transparency, and regulatory compliance.

A veteran of the domain name industry, Danko combines governance rigor with deep operational insight. He currently serves as a Non-Executive Director of RNIDS (Serbian National Internet Domain Registry), where he oversees the registry's alignment with public interest goals. Previously, during his initial Board tenure (2007–2009), he architected the nation's sovereign transition from .yu to .rs — managing the complex retirement of a country code. Later, as CEO (2013–2017), he directed the registry's technical modernization. This comprehensive background provides him with firsthand experience in registry stability, DNS abuse mitigation, and crisis management.

Danko's governance credentials include service as Treasurer of CENTR (Association of European Country-Code Registries), where he strengthened financial compliance for the 50+ member association. He was also appointed by the UN Secretary-General to the Internet Governance Forum's Multistakeholder Advisory Group (MAG), representing the technical community of Eastern Europe. He is a PhD candidate in Economics and holds directorship certifications from INSEAD (France, EU), National Association of Corporate Directors (NACD, USA), Harvard Business School, and Carnegie Mellon.

Based in Belgrade, Serbia, he brings a vital perspective from a transitional economy, championing bottom-up, multistakeholder models that foster trusted digital ecosystems.
